Open doors weekend in 38 museums – A rich programme full of discoveries.

The Luxembourg Museum Days 2025 will take place on May 17 and 18 – an open doors weekend across the country inspired by ICOM's International Museum Day celebrations. For one weekend, 38 museums will offer free access to their permanent and temporary exhibitions, along with a special programme full of surprises.

Creative workshops, special guided tours, concerts, performances, family-friendly activities, and more – the Luxembourg Museum Days 2025 invite everyone to (re)discover the museums in a new way.

The 2024 edition was a resounding success, drawing a record-breaking 22.271 visits, the highest attendance since the event began 28 years ago.

Since 1977, the International Museum Day has been organised annually on May 18 by ICOM (International Council of Museums). This year's theme, "The Future of Museums in Rapidly Changing Communities", focuses on how museums can navigate and contribute to a world undergoing profound social, technological, and environmental shifts.
